Mandorah Jetty upgrade works Upgrade of hand rails

The Mandorah Jetty walkway will receive new steel hand rails to replace the existing timber rails to enhance safety and durability.

Visitors and ferry passengers will be able to walk along the jetty with pedestrian access as per usual arrangements, and the ferry service will run as scheduled. The work zone is restricted to the jetty walkway and will not affect the jetty head area.

Fishing remains permitted from the jetty head during the scheduled works, however fishing will not be permitted from the jetty walkway during the works. The work area is shown on map below.

The work will begin on Wednesday 19 May and is scheduled for completion in July 2021. The new hand rails will include fishing rod holders near the jetty head.

Design work on new marine facilities for Mandorah continues to be finalised, with a construction tender to be released in late 2021 ahead of expected construction start in the 2022 dry season.
