

Civic and State Square Revitalisation

Changes to parking conditions

Earlier this month the Northern Territory Government announced the next stages of the Civic and State Square Revitalisation.

The revitalisation forms part of the Territory Government’s historic Darwin City Deal, delivered in partnership with the Australian Government and the City of Darwin, and will transform the precinct into a welcoming and interactive green heart of the CBD.

The next stages of the initiative will be delivered by local company, Sitzler Pty Ltd, and include construction of the Northern Territory Art Gallery (formally known as the State Square Art Gallery).

As construction on site commences, there will be changes to the current traffic and parking conditions.

From 30 November 2022:

- existing driveway access for visitors to the Supreme Court will be inaccessible*
- The Old Town Ruins car parks will also be inaccessible as they form part of the construction site

* detours will be in place for authorised vehicles (for example deliveries), only from Bennett Street.

A secure perimeter fence will be established by the contractor around the construction site.
